awarded \$8,562 in 2019-2020.**

**We thank all youth applicants for their dedication to service.**

- Alma College received \$1,600 to host Victory Day for youth with disabilities to have an opportunity to play football and cheer;
- Alma High School's Student Council received \$500 to support the school's food pantry which is available during the school year to hungry students;
- Alma's Pine Avenue Elementary Student Leadership Council received \$370.00 for the Bridging Generations project joining youth together with residents of Arbor Grove Assisted Living;
- Alma High School's Life Skills classes will learn to cook, and sew and use those skills to provide people in need with a homemade meal, warm articles of clothing and blankets. They received \$500 for their Helping Those in Need program.
- Carrie Knause Early Childhood Learning Center in St. Louis received \$350 for Mrs. Vance's Kindergarten class to make placemats for the Meals on Wheels program;
