- Gratiot Isabella RESD received \$10,000 for the enrollment of Gratiot County children in the Dolly Parton Imagination Library;
- Gratiot County Commission on Aging received \$5,800 to provide bedside commodes to senior citizens in Gratiot County to reduce the risk of falling;
- St. Louis Area Fire Department received \$8,524 for fire hose and water supply upgrades;
- Child Advocacy received \$5,000 for the Shop with a Hero program to promote positive officer and youth relations;
