



GCCF awarded \$76,213 during its Fall 2021 grant cycle.

We thank all applicants for their time in applying.

- City of Alma received \$6,500 to purchase a drone for the Alma Police Department that will be available to all emergency services in Gratiot County;
- City of Alma received \$14,526 for the Alma District Rescue Lucas Device to increase the chance of survival from sudden cardiac arrest for the citizens of Alma District Rescue response territory;
- Alma Public Schools received \$810 to cover the cost of a professional theatre experience for high school students to see *A Christmas Carol* at the Meadow Brook Theatre;
- Ashley Community Schools received \$10,000 to make their weight room equipment safer, available, and more efficient to improve community health through exercise;
- Alma Public Schools received \$1,377 to cover the costs of Alma High School students to visit the Detroit Institute of Arts and Detroit City Tour;
- Day Dreams, Inc. received \$10,000 to purchase a commercial building for their resale shop and other vocational, social, and recreational activities for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities;
- Child Advocacy received \$20,000 to assist with the Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) Program to aid in supporting staff, recruiting and training volunteers, and maintaining advocacy services;
- Gratiot Emergency Housing Corporation received \$6,000 to provide assistance to Gratiot County residents who are facing a housing crisis and in danger of losing their residence, or are in need of securing a residence;
- City of Alma received \$5,000 to replace and enhance the Alma Public Library Storywalk;
- Alma College received \$2,000 for a pre-college summer art program for Gratiot County High School Students to introduce the rigors of visual art making achieved at the college level.
