

GCCF awarded \$53,928 during its Fall 2022 grant cycle. We thank all applicants for their time in applying.

- St. Louis Public Schools received \$7,344 to purchase a laser engraver to help support community projects and prepare students for future careers;
- Child Advocacy received \$6,900 to aid in the development of the Gratiot County Breastfeeding Coalition;
- Ithaca North Elementary received \$5,000 to help students with the cost to attend 6th grade camp;
- Junior Achievement of North Central Michigan received \$2,500 towards Junior Achievement programs for Gratiot County schools;
- Gratiot County Historical and Genealogical Society received \$900 to update and increase the number of computers in the library;
- Gratiot Emergency Services Authority (GESA) received \$14,834 to purchase a LUCAS device that will increase the chance of survival from sudden cardiac arrest;
- Great Start Collaborative received \$1,500 to provide childcare and a meal at each Parent Café for the 2022-2023 school year;
- Seventh-Day Adventist Church and Gratiot County Community Service Center received \$7,000 to meet the basic needs of students of all ages through purchasing clothing and bedding for My School Closet;
