

GCCF awarded \$85,963 during its Spring 2023 grant cycle. We thank all applicants for their time in applying.

- Ashley Community Schools received \$496.50 for the Detroit Institute of Arts Field Trip;
- Child Advocacy received \$3,350 to combat the use of vape/electronic cigarettes at Breckenridge
 High School by installing vape detectors;
- St. Louis Area Fire Department received \$15,000 to help aid in funding the Heavy Rescue Replacement project, ensuring the truck has adequate safety features for both responders and residents;
- Alma Public Schools received \$2,652 for students to visit the Detroit Institute of Arts and tour downtown Detroit;
- Alma Public Schools received \$3,800 for students to visit the Henry Ford Museum, Detroit Opera House, and perform the National Anthem for a Detroit Tigers Game;
- Gratiot County Central Dispatch received \$7,350 to replace the Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) computers;
