



GCCF awarded \$83,700 during its Fall 2023 grant cycle.

We thank all applicants for their time in applying.

- Ithaca South Elementary received \$7,500 to help fund a new playscape for the playground;
- St. Louis Public Schools received \$10,000 to aid in renovating existing space within the school facility to appropriately accommodate a Child & Adolescent Health Center;
- Breckenridge Community Schools received \$504 to add more novels and low-level, age-appropriate materials to the middle/high school library;
- Alma Community Arts Center received \$7,500 to aid in replacing the current roof on the Alma Community Arts Center building;
- Michigan Arts Access received \$6,500 for the Artists in Residence in Gratiot County program which provides arts education to students with disabilities and an opportunity for creative expression;
- Alma College received \$5,000 for the Rocks, Minerals, and Fossils in Gratiot County project;
- Alma Highland Festival and Games and City of Alma received \$14,884 to purchase staging to assist the Highland Dance events and other community events;
- Ithaca Adventist Community Service Center received \$8,000 to purchase clothing and shoes for the My School Closet program;
- Child Advocacy received \$5,528 to purchase materials for Child Sexual Abuse Prevention programs;
- Forest Hill Nature Area and Gratiot-Isabella RESD received \$9,783 to purchase all-terrain strollers to allow students the opportunity to experience nature up close;
- Commission on Aging received \$6,500 to provide transport wheelchairs to Gratiot County residents aged 60 or older; and
- Ithaca North Elementary School received \$2,000 to help offset the cost of 6th grade camp in 2024 for students who are unable to fundraise to attend camp.
